PREFACE

This volume of the Occasional Papers of the Kagoshima University Research Center for the South Pacific is the record of a symposium entitled "Papua New Guinean Life and Nutrition". I organized this symposium and it was held under the chairmanship of Prof. Shin-ichi TERASHI (Kagoshima University Research Center for the South Pacific) on the Kagoshima University campus on February 23, 1983. It centered upon the three reports shown in the table of Contents.

One of the reasons for holding the symposium under the foregoing title was that the Research Center was planning to organize a scientific expedition to Papua New Guinea and that this symposium would provide the planners and would-be participants of the project with useful knowledge for their surveys.
