A-D: Various landscapes in the islands. **A:** Yakushima Is., Second largest island in Kagoshima Prefecture. **B:** Kuchinoerabujima Is., active volcanic island in Osumi Islands. **C:** Takeshima Is., a small and flat island with less than 100 inhabitants. **D:** Tokunoshima Is., an island surrounded by coral reefs and part of the Amami Islands.
